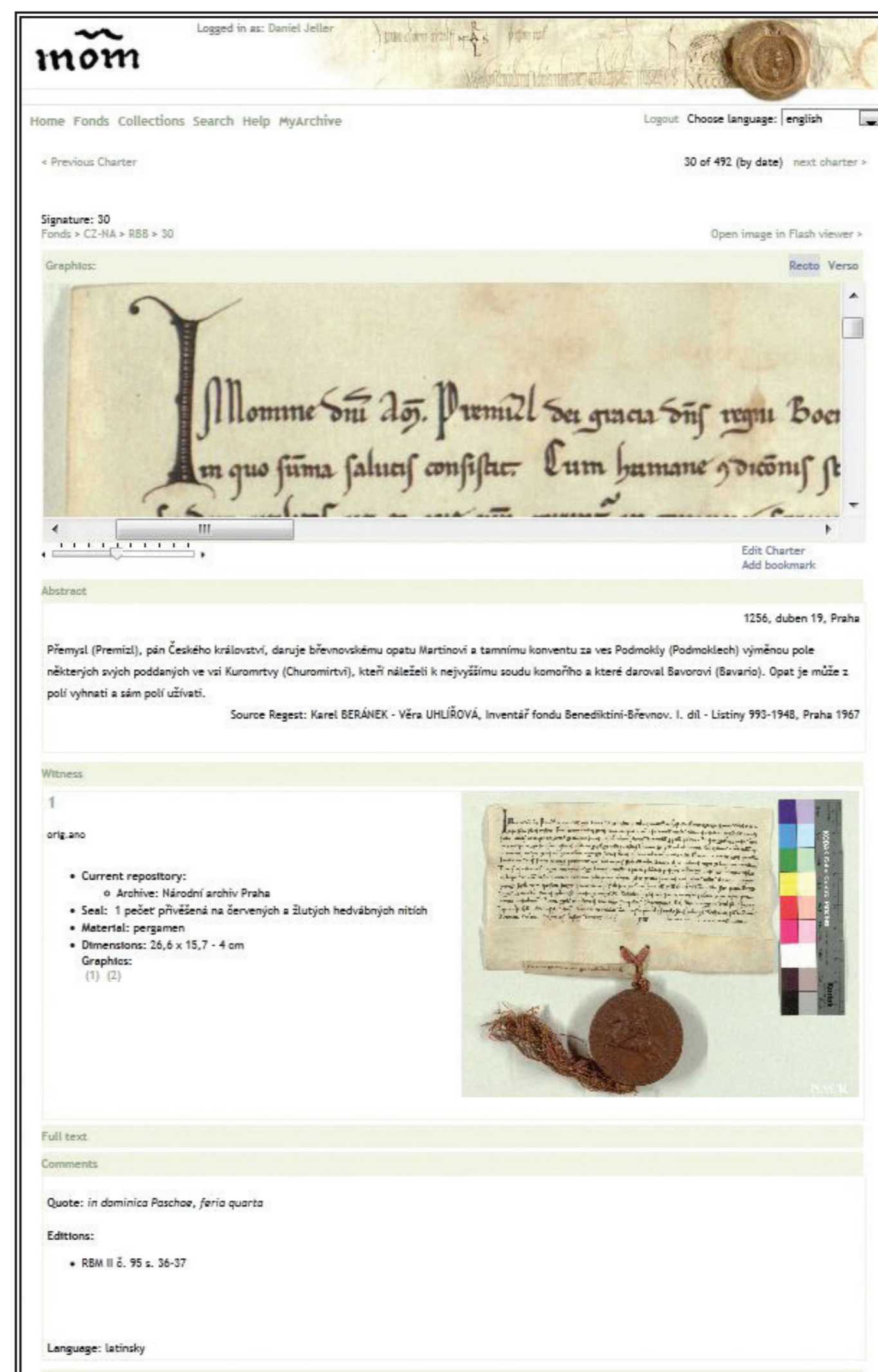

AIMS

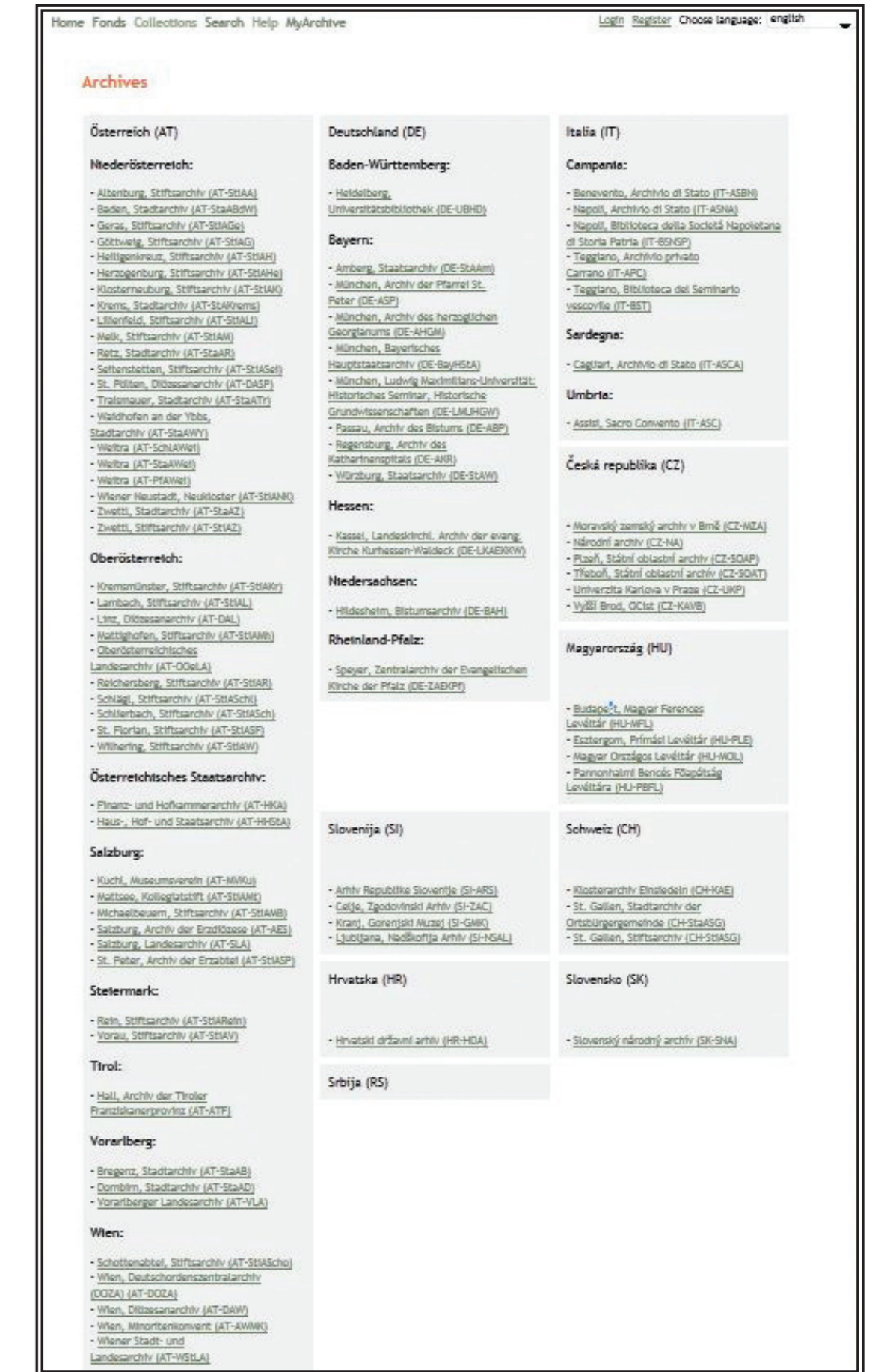
- MOM-CA aims at developing the means for expert researchers and interested enthusiasts to view and browse a broad spectrum of historical source materials, starting with more than 200.000 medieval and early modern charters including detailed metadata and high quality digital images.
- MOM-CA provides users with all necessary tools to improve the large amount of already existing data for its various historical sources or to create new editions completely from scratch.
- MOM-CA enables the owners of the original source material and other content moderators to review all changes made to a digital representation of any original source and communicate with its editors to ensure professional quality and scientific accuracy.
- MOM-CA uses modern XML standards and technologies (XRX) to ensure high data portability and reliable performance and is OpenSource software (1).

- 2005: Start of the development of editMOM
- 2006: First public mention at the .hist 2006
- 2007: Replacement for the old database software
- 2008: Renamed to MOM-CA
- 2008-2010: Complete redesign of the database software
- 2011: Release of MOM-CA 1.5

FEATURES FOR RESEARCHERS

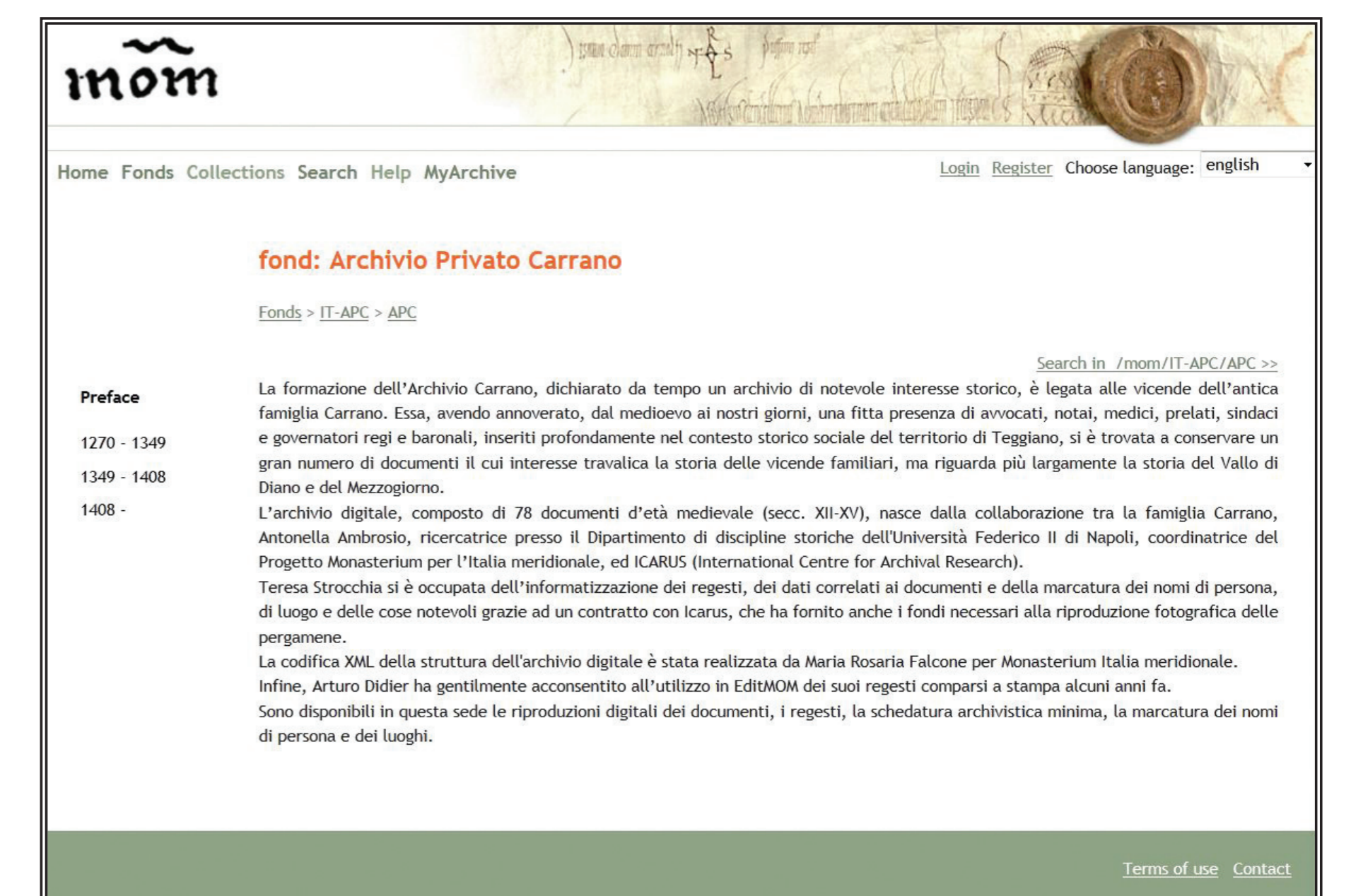
- Browsing through over 80 fonds and collections from institutions in 10 European countries

UPCOMING FEATURES

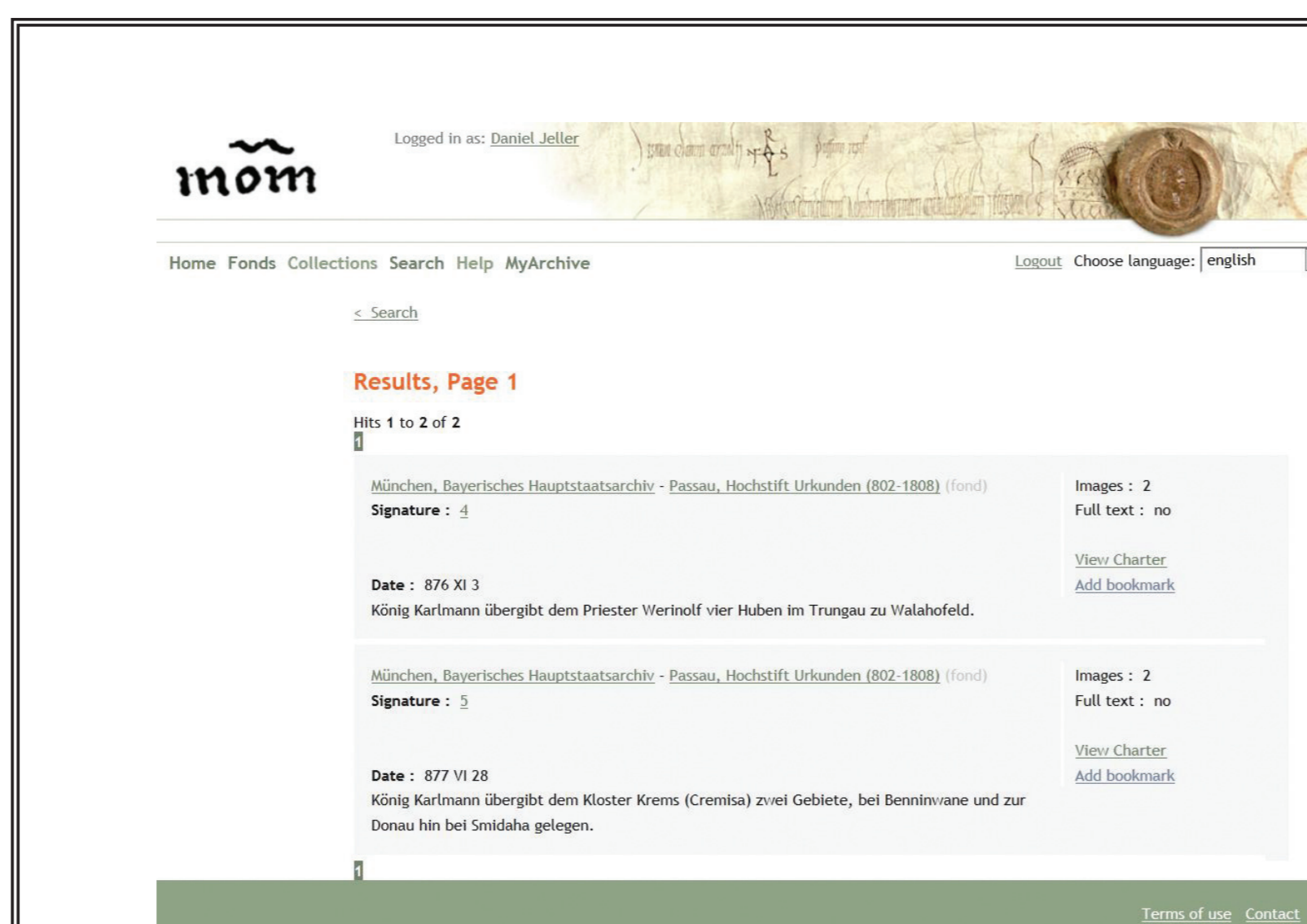
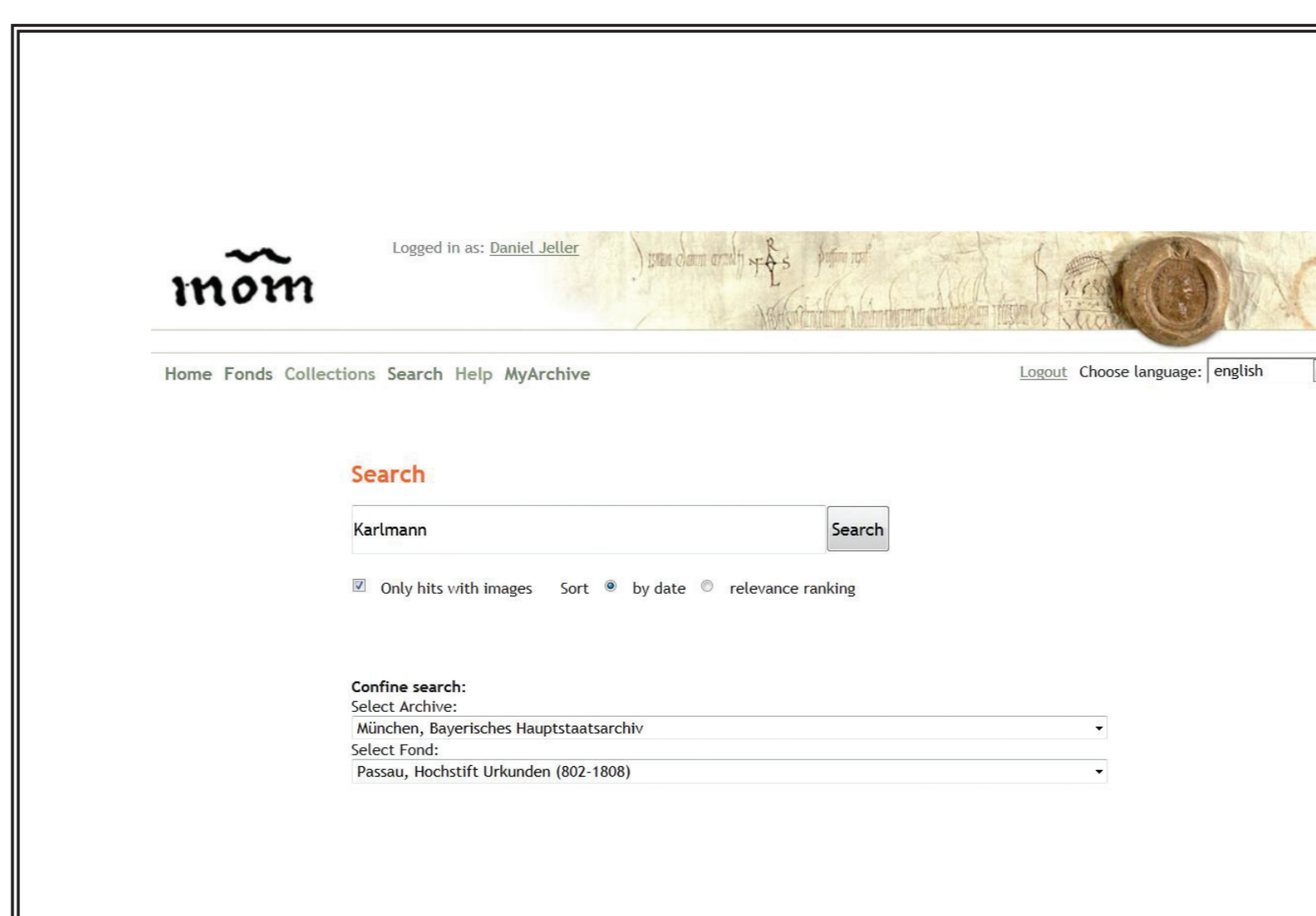
- Ability to merge interesting documents into a public user collection
- Complete redesign of the XML editor using AJAX instead of a JAVA applet
- Improved user and contribution management for moderators
- Further search engine optimization

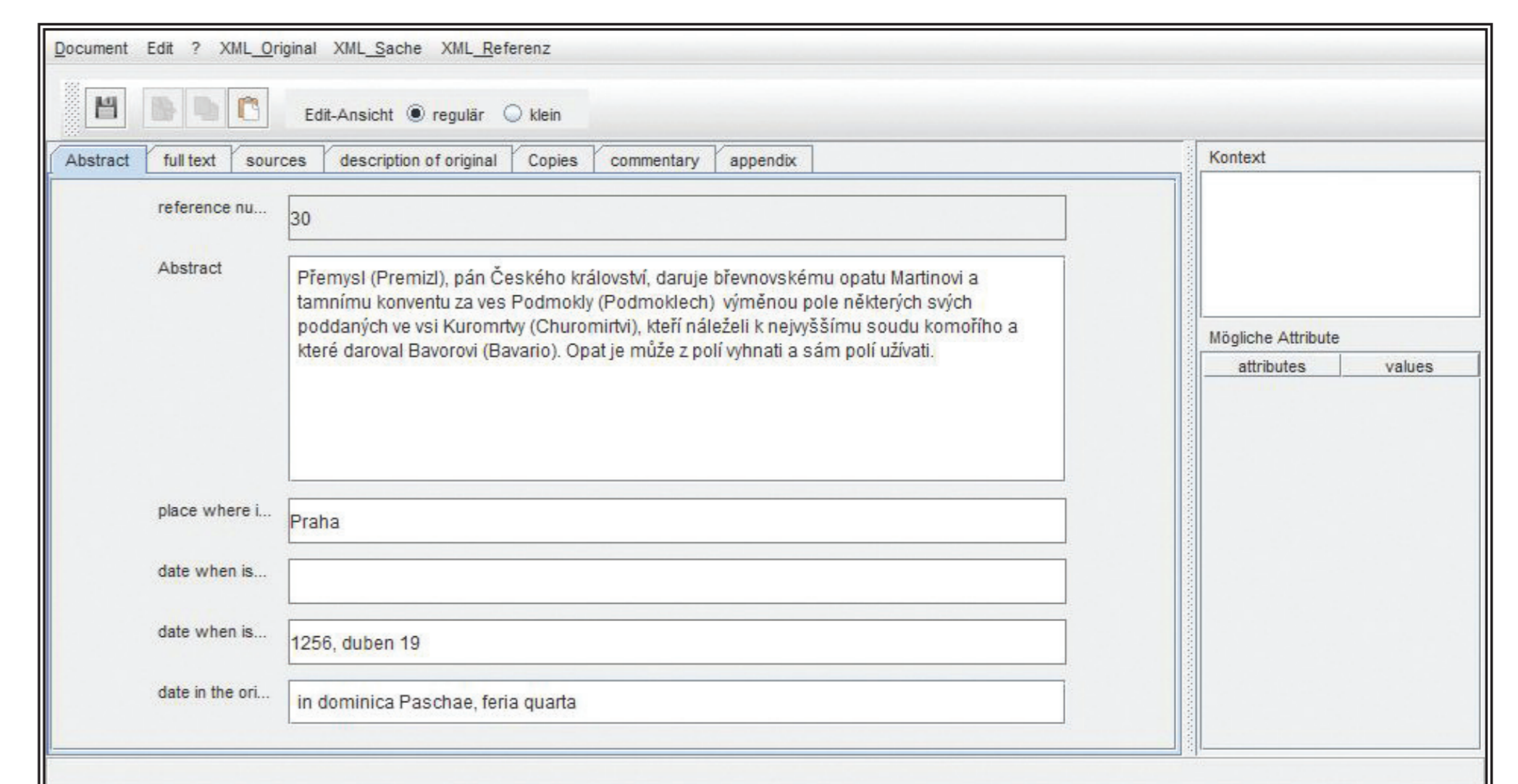

Search and results

POSSIBILITIES FOR COLLABORATION

- User page for easy access to all documents in use
- Completely web based editor
- Easy to use and context sensitive XML markup feature
- Access to a wide range of metadata tags including the possibility to mark persons, locations and other content depending on the object's XML Schema
- Cloud based storage of all edits
- Sending all changes on the item to the item's moderator for quality control
- Publishing all changes
